## Ian Sadlak

**Ian Sadlak** is a professor at the European Center of the Babes-Bolyai University, in Cluj-Napoca, Romania. In October 2009 he was elected as a president of the International Observatory for Academic Ranking and Excellence at IREG. Professor Ian Sadlak is an internationally recognized and cited expert on policy, management and administration of higher education. His research interests include the processes of reforming and transformation in higher education and science policy, the organization of doctoral studies, obtaining qualifications, private higher education, world-class universities, quality assurance, academic ranking and ethical dimensions of higher education and academic values.

Ian Sadlak is a member of the editorial board for leading journals in the field of higher education and social policy, including the journal «Higher Education Management» (published by OECD). In September 2009, Pope Benedict XVI appointed him as a member of the Board of Directors at Agenzia della Santa Sede per la Valutazione e la Promozione della Qualità e Facoltà Ecclesiastiche (AVEPRO) (Agency Holy See for the assessment and promotion of quality in Catholic universities and schools). Professor Sadlak was given several awards of excellence and was awarded with six titles "Honorary Doctor» (Doctor honoris causa) at the leading universities of Romania, the Russian Federation and Ukraine.

Jan Sadlak is a corresponding member of the European Academy of Arts, Sciences and Humanities in Paris (France) and a member of the World Academy of Arts and Sciences in San Francisco (USA). In the period from September 2009 to January 2011 he was a professor and vice-rector for International Cooperation at the Warsaw School of Social Sciences and Humanities / SWPS. From October 1999 to July 2009 he worked as a director of the European Centre for Higher Education (UNESCO-CEPES) and the representative of UNESCO in Romania. Previously, he held the position of the Head of Department for Policies in Higher Education, UNESCO, Paris (1992 - 1999). Professor Ian Sadlak got his PhD degree in Management in education (in 1988) in SUNY / Buffalo University, USA and his Master degree in Economics (1968) at the Academy of Economics named after "Oskar Lange" in Wroclaw, Poland.
