Jamil Salmi is an international expert in the field of higher education, who provides advisory services to governments of some countries, universities, international and regional banks and agencies. Until January 2012, he hold a position of a coordinator for issues in higher education in the World Bank. Jamil Salmi was the first to write a policy document of the World Bank on higher education in 1994, and was also the author of the strategy of the World Bank in the same field in 2002. The title of the strategy is "Constructing Knowledge Societies: New Challenges for Tertiary Education". Over the past 20 years, Jamil Salmi consulted on political issues in the field of reform and strategic development of the higher education system of public universities and management executives from more than 80 countries around the world.

Jamil Salmi is a member of the International Board of Trustees in a number of universities in Europe, Asia and Latin America. It is also a member of the International Observation Network of the British foundation in higher education (of the International Advisory Network of the UK Leadership Foundation for Higher Education), the Publishing Committee of the journal on management and policies in higher education by OECD (OECD Journal of Higher Education Management and Policy). Between 2008 and 2011, Jamil Salmi represented the World Bank in the Governing Board of the International Institute for Educational Planning.

In 2009, Jamil Salmi published a book "Challenge of Establishing World-Class Universities". His latest book, which he published in collaboration with Professor Philip Altbach in September 2011 (Professor Phil Altbach), is called "The Road to Academic Excellence: the Making of World-Class Research Universities".
